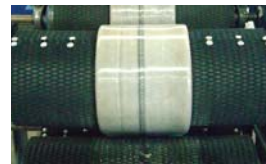

MTube® Integra™ Installation Process

MTube® Integra™ is installed using a pull-in process, which means reduced stress on the tube as compared to other methods, a smaller jobsite footprint and **decreased installation cycle time**.



Step 1:

MTube® Integra™ must be wet out (impregnated with resin) before installation.



Step 2:

Using a pull-in method, the resin saturated liner is inserted into an existing sanitary or storm sewer. Air is used to inflate the tube and steam cures the resin to form a tight fitting, jointless and corrosion resistant replacement pipe.



Step 3:

Before reinstating the sewer pipeline, service laterals must be restored and the rehabilitated pipe inspected by closed-circuit TV.
